

**ORDINANCE NO. 2022-07**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF HARVEY CEDARS AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 8 OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF HARVEY CEDARS, 1975, ENTITLED “TRAFFIC” AS IT PERTAINS TO NO PARKING AND NO U-TURNS ON CERTAIN STREETS**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE BOROUGH OF HARVEY CEDARS** as follows:

- Section 1.** Schedule I of Chapter 8 of the Borough Code of the Borough of Harvey Cedars entitled “No Parking” is hereby amended by supplementing the following:
1. Anchor Lane, East Side, beginning at the rumble strips for a length of 100’ feet
- Section 2.** Schedule III of Chapter 8 of the Borough Code of the Borough of Harvey Cedars entitled “No Stopping or Standing” is hereby amended by supplementing the following:
- Long Beach Blvd., Both Sides, Entire Length
- Section 3.** Schedule XIV of Chapter 8 of the Borough Code of the Borough of Harvey Cedars entitled “No U-Turn” is hereby amended by supplementing the following:
- Meadowview Lane
- Section 4.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
- Section 5.** If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions.
- Section 6.** This Ordinance shall take effect upon final adoption after publication in accordance with law.
