What bags are banned?




**Plastic

Exemptions, bags for:



Uncooked meat,
fish, or poultry



Loose items
such as produce




Prescription drugs



Newspaper


Contain live animals, such as fish
Sliced food/prepared to order including soup hot food
Laundry, dry cleaning or garment

What foam products are banned?



Disposable food containers Polystyrene plates, cups, food trays & utensils

Exemptions, extra two-year grace period




Trays for raw meat,
poultry, or fish



Cups of 2 oz
or less
for hot foods



Disposable,
long-handled
plastic spoons
for thick drinks



Any food
pre-packaged
in polystyrene
by manufacturer
