The Mayor stated this is regarding the municipal parking at Borough Hall, sometimes the parking gets tied up with different uses; (parking spaces) needs to be more accessible to the public during business hours and meetings.

Mr. Bob Kaplon of West 76<sup>th</sup> Street asked why there are "No Parking" signs now when the ordinance has not been approved; he stated this only effects the 76<sup>th</sup> Street residents; he doesn't object to the ordinance, but does object on how it's going to be handled by the police; according to the ordinance it is not "No Parking", it is limited parking; the handicap parking spot is twice what it should be, another parking spot can be gained; he asked has this been really thought through and has the police department been educated on the ordinance.

The Mayor responded: the signs were placed to start educating the public and believes the ordinance is not being enforced at this time because it is not in effect; the whole lot will be reconfigured when the new well is installed; also working on employee parking; handicap spots are very specific. Commissioner Gerkens added the handicap spot was redesigned by County requirements for elections. The Mayor stated there are many things in town being corrected for handicap accessibility. The Mayor mentioned the new Public Safety Director Jerry Falkowski is present and will be informing the police department; the intent is to have more parking available during business hours and meetings, not while the borough is closed.

The Municipal Clerk clarified the signs posted in the parking lot were supposed to read "Municipal Parking Only", but the rain washed the taped message off the "No Parking" sign; the Clerk apologized and said it will be corrected.

Safety Director Jerry Falkowski stated the parking situation has just come to his attention and he has assigned an officer the task to configure parking more efficiently, it will be addressed.

Mr. Jim Finne of West 76<sup>th</sup> Street stated he assumed this ordinance was written mainly for himself as a violator; families grow from 1 car to 6, and they have been freely using the parking lot; he could have been asked not to park; the Rosenfeld property ("shell lot" west of the Borough paved lot) was taken for parking but has turned into police storage, it is unsightly and the lighting is offensive. He stated his house is a legal duplex and he depends on the income; he has taken steps to limit the cars and has informed tenants. The Mayor stated there were parking issues in the past of the restaurant also using the lot, the whole parking matter needs to be fixed. Commissioner Garofalo said the plan is to make it better once the well project is done.

Mr. Finne's house manager asked if parking is allowed at the bay beach and in the lot. The Mayor said it is allowed at the bay beach and in the borough lot as long as there is not a meeting. Commissioner Gerkens said the ordinance specifically states during borough hours and meetings. Mr. Kaplon stated the police knocked at the Vazzano's door at 11:45pm to move a car. It was unclear whether this took place this summer or last summer. Commissioner Garofalo was unaware of this, but said he will look into it.

The Clerk responded the policy is to see the person with the I.D., but the office staff are willing to meet seniors at their home or in the car. Ms. Lehman asked on behalf of the Taxpayers Association, if the lifetime senior beach badge can be reinstated. The Mayor asked the Clerk to find out what other communities on the Island are doing for senior badges.

Mr. Finne's house manager inquired how many beach wheelchairs are available; Commissioner Gerkens stated there are 13 chairs, and they are delivered to the house, unlike a lot of the other towns that do not deliver.

# RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF HARVEY CEDARS, COUNTY OF OCEAN, AUTHORIZING VERIZON WIRELESS TO USE EXISTING UTILITY POLES IN THE BOROUGH'S RIGHT-OF-WAY FOR THE INSTALLATION OF COMMUNICATION EQUIPMENT

**WHEREAS** Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless, ("Verizon Wireless"), is a provider of commercial mobile service subject to regulation by the Federal Communications Commission; and

**WHEREAS** Verizon Wireless has entered into agreements with parties that have the lawful right to maintain poles in the public right-of-way pursuant to which Verizon Wireless may use such poles erected within the public right-of-way in the Borough of Harvey Cedars; and

WHEREAS New Jersey law permits such use provided that there is the consent of the relevant municipality; and

WHEREAS the Borough of Harvey Cedars adopted Ordinance 2019-01 regulating communications facilities as it relates to towers and monopoles without specifically addressing utility poles; and

WHEREAS the Mayor and Superintendent have visited locations of the proposed node installations with Verizon Wireless representatives and have agreed to grant authorization of the installations at specific locations.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Commissioners of the Borough of Harvey Cedars, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey that permission and authority are hereby granted to Verizon Wireless to install and maintain seven (7) small wireless facilities (nodes) on utility poles within the public right-of-way in the Borough of Harvey Cedars, as listed in the attached Schedule A, subject to the following:

- A. Verizon Wireless, and its successors and assigns, shall adhere to all applicable Federal, State, and Local laws regarding safety requirements related to the use of the public right-of-way.
- B. Verizon Wireless, and its successors and assigns, shall comply with all applicable Federal, State, and Local laws requiring permits prior to beginning construction, and shall obtain any applicable permits that may be required by the Borough of Harvey Cedars.
- C. Such permission be and is hereby given upon the condition and provision that Verizon Wireless, and its successors and assigns, shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless the Borough of Harvey Cedars, its officers, agents, and servants, from any claim of liability or loss or bodily injury or property damage resulting from or arising out of the acts or omissions of Verizon Wireless or its agents in connection with the use and occupancy poles located within the public right-of-way, except to the extent resulting from the acts or omissions of the Borough of Harvey Cedars.
- D. Verizon Wireless shall, at its own cost and expense, maintain commercial general liability insurance with limits not less than \$1,000,000 for injury to or death of one or more persons in any one occurrence and \$500,000 for damage or destruction to property in any one occurrence. Verizon Wireless shall include the Borough of Harvey Cedars as an additional insured.

- E. Verizon Wireless shall be responsible for the repair of any damage to paving, existing utility lines, or any surface or subsurface installations, arising from its construction, installation or maintenance of its facilities.
- F. Notwithstanding any provision contained herein, neither the Borough of Harvey Cedars nor Verizon Wireless shall be liable to the other for consequential, incidental, exemplary, or punitive damages on account of any activity pursuant to this instrument.
- G. This instrument shall be adopted on behalf of the Borough of Harvey Cedars by the Board of Commissioners of the Borough of Harvey Cedars and attested to by Borough of Harvey Cedars Clerk who shall affix the Borough of Harvey Cedars Seal thereto.
- H. The permission and authority hereby granted shall continue for the same period of time as the grant to parties whose poles Verizon Wireless is using.

# AUTHORIZING THE COLLECTION OF DONATIONS TO THE OPEN SPACE TRUST FUND FOR THE ACQUISITION OF PROPERTY

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 2-15 of the Harvey Cedars General Ordinances, the Open Space Trust Fund was established to collect funds and accept donations to be utilized for the purchase of property rights within the Borough of Harvey Cedars from willing sellers; and

WHEREAS there is a potential willing seller of the James Street Wetlands (aka Block 1 Lot 1) in the amount of \$200,000; and

WHEREAS the Borough received approval from the State of New Jersey for a Green Acres matching grant of \$50,000 for the James Street Wetlands; and

WHEREAS the Current Market Value of said property obtained from the Green Acres approved appraiser is \$50,000; and

WHEREAS the Green Acres program will only fund up to the appraised value; and

WHEREAS the Board of Commissioners is willing to subsidize said purchase in the total amount of \$125,000 utilizing \$100,000 from the Open Space Trust Fund and \$25,000 from the Green Acres funds; and

**WHEREAS** the Board desires to accept donations for the remainder of the \$75,000.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Commissioners of the Borough of Harvey Cedars, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey as follows:

- 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the acceptance of donations to be used and recorded exclusively for the purchase of Block 1 Lot 1 in conjunction with funding from the Open Space Trust Fund and the Green Acres Grant.
- 2. The Chief Finance Officer of the Borough of Harvey Cedars is hereby directed to deposit and record the donations from each donor into the Open Space Trust Fund.
- 3. Should the Borough be unsuccessful of the acquisition of Block 1 Lot 1, the Chief Finance Officer is hereby directed to refund all donations in full.
