The Mayor discussed the concept of having the Borough collect trash with the arm/can pickup, however there are issues to consider such as the weekend residents/renters. The increased amount will make it tough for the budget next year.

The Mayor stated he received good comments regarding the monthly emails. Kathy Ries said she will include a message to the Taxpayers Association to sign up for the Borough emails. The Mayor asked her to also include a message asking to donate to the Fire Company since there were no fundraisers this year; donations are tax deductible.

PRIVILEGE OF THE FLOOR -

Steve Sepanak asked about the possible automated arm trash pickup, will the cans fit in the existing corrals or do the corrals go away? The Mayor gave an example of Beach Haven West, where there are no corrals, the cans are rolled out the night before trash pickup and then rolled back; it looks much nicer without the corrals and the cans. The Mayor said usually the town purchases the first can, the homeowner could purchase more; the real problem is turnovers and if one leaves for the week, who pushes the can in and out. A discussion continued with ideas of modifying the corrals and how the logistics would work.

Commissioner Imperiale updated Steve Sepanak that the Land Use ordinances are still being worked on.

Kathy Ries mentioned the Joint Council of Taxpayers Association (JCTA) has had conversations regarding the coyotes on the north end of the Island, and in the Harvey Cedars email newsletter it was mentioned a sighting in Harvey Cedars and in Holgate. A discussion continued regarding the coyotes; they have been seen up and down the Island, have been heard howling, they are a protected species and not much can be done by the Animal Control.
