TOPICS OF INTEREST -

Commissioner Imperiale and Rice wished all a Happy Holiday.

Mayor Oldham stated Cedars Avenue paving is complete; the Boulevard project has a few items being worked on, such as the grates; the Fire Company is having a "Santa Run" on Wednesday; and he is looking forward to 2020 passing and 2021 coming on.

PRIVILEGE OF THE FLOOR -

Jim Fritz asked if Harvey Cedars is involved or has an update on the offshore wind project. The Mayor said there are a lot of opinions on this subject, but it has not been discussed by the Board yet. A discussion was held with the Board and members of the public including, Kathy Ries and Britta Forsberg Wenzel of Save Barnegat Bay. Ms. Wenzel stated Save Barnegat Bay has not endorsed any wind farm project, while they are supportive of alternative energy sources, this project is a massive installment going off the coast of NJ and there is a concern of the impact it will have to the local fishing community. She pointed out the professional lobbyists on behalf of the project have stated at public meetings that the project will not restrict commercial or recreational fishers from being in the zone of where the facilities are, however the lobbyist do not mention that other enforcement agencies on behalf of the United States will; fisherman have stated it will restrict their abilities and livelihood safely at sea; the project will have distributions lines from the windmills to Oyster Creek for power, the lines will run through eelgrass beds in Barnegat Bay; the electromagnetic field that emanates from the power lines may impact the reproduction ability of blue claw crabs; the alternative energy and environmental concerns must be weighed. The Mayor added the noise from the windmills may not be heard from the shoreline but may affect the fishing industry; his understanding is that the windmills will be much larger than the ones in Atlantic City. Kathy Ries stated she will bring this subject up with the Joint Taxpayers Association.

Ms. Wenzel thanked the Commissioners for passing the resolution to purchase Block 1 Lot 1, it will be a benefit to nature as well as to the residents in that neighborhood.

Kathy Ries asked if the spray paint on the Cedars Avenue driveways will be removed. The Mayor stated it should just wash away. She asked what was the timeline of the Block 1 Lot

1 contract. Mayor Oldham said there are details that need to be worked out with putting together the contracts; it will probably go into the beginning of the year.

Ms. Ries asked what action or involvement is being done to address the growing coyote problem. Commissioner Imperiale said the Animal Control is in charge, but there is not much that can be done except to alert the residents. Ms. Ries said other municipalities are taking action on that, she knows there is a movement on the way by Long Beach. The Chief stated if you see them stay away, and notify Animal Control.

WHEREAS the United States Congress authorized the Defense Logistics Agency (DLA) Law Enforcement Support Office (LESO) 1033 Program to make use of excess Department of Defense personal property by making that personal property available to municipal, county and State law enforcement agencies (LEAs); and

WHEREAS DLA rules mandate that all equipment acquired through the 1033 Program remain under the control of the requesting LEA; and

WHEREAS participation in the 1033 Program allows municipal and county LEAs to obtain property they might not otherwise be able to afford in order to enhance community preparedness, response, and resiliency; and

WHEREAS although property is provided through the 1033 Program at no cost to municipal and county LEAs, these entities are responsible for the costs associated with delivery, maintenance, fueling, and upkeep of the property, and for specialized training on the operation of any acquired property; and

WHEREAS N.J.S.A. 40A:5-30.2 requires that the governing body of the municipality to approve, by a majority of the full membership, both enrollment in, and the acquisition of any property through, the 1033 Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Borough of Harvey Cedars that the Harvey Cedars Police Department is hereby authorized to enroll in the 1033 Program for no more than a one-year period, with authorization to participate terminating on December 31 of the current calendar year from January 1, 2021 to December 31, 2021; and
