#### **COMMISSIONER REPORTS / TOPICS OF INTEREST**

Commissioner Rice shared that it is the time of the year that the finance department begins budget discussions. In closing Commissioner Rice thanked everyone that participated in any capacity at this years High Point Volunteer Fire Company Dog Day Road Race.

Patrick Greber -5 E.  $80^{th}$  Street - raised concerns over the ordinance regarding the trees. He asked if the trees being replaced once removed have to be the same size. Commissioner Rice confirmed that you would need to replace, but not match what was existing.

Walt Naisby -5 E.  $82^{nd}$  Street - questioned which aerators will be installed in Kinsey and Harvest Coves to assist in preventing Fishkill events. Commissioner Gieger explained that they will float and be anchored so they can be removed in the winter.
