COMMISSIONER REPORTS / TOPICS OF INTEREST

Commissioner Paul Rice stated that the Finance Department was able to secure a AA bond rating. He thanked and applauded Chief Financial Officer Rebecca Wessler on her hard work during the process. Mayor Imperiale added that a AA bond rating is the highest rating the borough can secure.

Commissioner Joseph Gieger shared that the Department of Parks, Public Property, and Public Works is in clean-up mode after a busy season.

Mayor John Imperiale advised the attendees to keep an eye out for the next edition of the Harvey Cedars Community Currents that will be filled with town wide updates and announcements. The mayor shared that it was a challenging summer for the Harvey Cedars Beach Patrol with rip current risks and acknowledged the swimmer that unfortunately lost his life the previous week.

Prior to privilege of the floor, the mayor reminded everyone that the borough would be hosting it's first Veterans Day event on November 8th at noon in Sunset Park. He invited all to attend!

PRIVLEGE OF THE FLOOR

Walt Naisby -5 E. 82^{nd} Street – questioned when and where the beach replenishment would take place. Mayor Imperiale shared that the replenishment would start in November or December. The replenishment is set to focus on streets beginning on 76^{th} Street and work south.

Robert Kaplon – 13 W. 76th Street – shared that the lack of bay beach fence along the boat entrance is causing a potential hazard for children in flotation devices and it should be rectified. Mr. Kaplon also mentioned that he had researched the organization the provides the Harvey Cedars Police Departments with their accredited status. He shared that the organization seemed to be a volunteer organization that is self-serving and questioned why we would be in partnership with them. Mayor Imperiale confirmed that he would reach out to Chief Burnaford.

Linda Kragie – 8 W. 75th Street – shared that after the paving on 75th Street seems to have fixed flooding issues.

Fred Schragger -7 E. Salem Avenue – questioned if the borough had retained an attorney to represent them during negotiations on the Harvey Cedars Police Department contract. Mayor Imperiale thanked him for his comment.

Jim Fritz -1 W. 82^{nd} Street - advised the board that they should re-visit the parking requirements in the borough. He mentioned that Azzurri patrons are parking in the HCH Realty parking lot. The commissioners shared that they are looking into commercial zoning.

Bob Budlow -13 E. 77^{th} – questioned if the patrons could be for Black Eyed Susans. Jim Fritz shared that the sharing of lots seemed to have started with the opening of Azzurri.

Sue Ellen Riffkin – 5 W. 77th Street – mentioned that some of the metallic street signs have lost their shine and cannot be seen at night. Commissioner Gieger confirmed that the signs are in the process of being replaced and will be finished in the next upcoming year. Ms. Riffkin continued her testimony with a request for the board to confirm how the Streetscape Projects were paid for. She added that rumors around town had her confused. The commissioners confirmed that the project was mostly paid entirely with grants with the remainder being covered by the borough.

RESOLUTION #2024-110

AUTHORIZING THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF OCEAN AND THE BOROUGH OF HARVEY CEDARS

WHEREAS, the restoration and preservation of Ocean County's beaches is essential as these unique natural resources constitute an important part of the ecology, environment, and economy of Ocean County that are enjoyed by residents throughout the state; and

WHEREAS, the federal government and the State of New Jersey have agreed to provide the Borough of Harvey Cedars (Borough) with funding to undertake the New Jersey Hurricane and Storm Reduction Projects (hereinafter "the Project"), subject to the Borough securing funding for twenty-five percent (25%) of the non-federal share cost of the Project (hereinafter "Municipal Share"); and

WHEREAS, the project is necessary in order to protect and preserve the County's beach ecosystem and to assure the continued use and enjoyment of the beachfront by the residents of Ocean County and the State in general; and

WHEREAS, the County of Ocean, in recognition of the necessity of the Project has agreed to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Borough, in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40:29-10, to provide the fifteen percent (15%) Local Share, in an amount not less than \$1,241,348.69, the estimated re-nourishment cost as outlined in the State of New Jersey Project #6006-HC-R2 (see Exhibit A) and Federal Flood Control Coastal Emergency Project; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has requested the County of Ocean apply their respective grant funds from the County through the American Rescue Plan funding to be applied to their required ten percent (10%) Municipal Share of the project, in an amount not less than \$827,565.79; and

WHEREAS, funds are now available in the 2024 County Budget from the appropriation entitled "ARPA-Revenue Replacement Beach Replenishment-Long Beach Island" Account Number 016-015-4609.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of the COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, as follows:

- 1. The Director and Clerk of the Board are hereby authorized and directed to enter into and execute an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Borough of Harvey Cedars to provide the twenty five percent (25%) Local Share, in an amount not less than \$2,068,914.48 for the estimated re-nourishment costs.
- 2. 2. The Director and Clerk of the Board are authorized and directed to execute any and all other documents that may be necessary to effectuate the purpose and intent of this Resolution and the Intergovernmental Agreements authorized herein.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Resolution shall be forwarded to the following: Borough of Harvey Cedars, County Administrator, Ocean County Comptroller: Director; Ocean County Management and Budget, and Ocean County Counsel.
