HARVEY CEDARS SFY 2017 TEST/PRODUCTION WELL PROJECT**

**WHEREAS**, Quad Construction was awarded a contract for the SFY2017 Test/Production Well Project in the Borough of Harvey Cedars, pursuant to Resolution #2024-066 in the amount of (\$2,230,000.00) as per the bid received November 16, 2023; and

**WHEREAS**, after the bid, the Borough requested design changes as follows: After being awarded the contract, the Owner/Engineer requested multiple design changes as follows: (1) New building location was moved, requiring additional electrical wire/conduit, additional water and sewer main piping and additional excavation for all of these; (2) Vinyl siding was changed from Cedar Impressions to NuCedar siding and trim; (3) Aluminum railing changed to FRP Railing; and (4) Add observation tubes to existing well for testing purposes. In addition to these changes, since the original well plan required the well pump to be grouted in place, the well driller proposed an alternate plan that would allow removal of the pump for repairs/replacement; and

**WHEREAS**, sufficient funds are available and certified by the Chief Financial Officer from the appropriation made by Ordinance #2017-05, Amended by Ordinance #2022-18, Account C-08-55-215-000-174 in the amount of Ninety-Nine Thousand One Hundred Ninety-One and Thirty-Three Cents (\$99,191.33)

WHEREAS, the Borough of Harvey Cedars recognizes the dedication and service of its long-term non-union employees who have contributed to the success and functioning of the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the Borough seeks to support its non-union employees by offering benefits that recognize and reward their loyalty and commitment to public service; and

WHEREAS, the Borough wishes to extend health insurance coverage to eligible non-union employees who have retired from Borough service and meet the specific criteria set forth below;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and the Board of Commissioners of the Borough of Harvey Cedars, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, as follows:

**1. Eligibility for Insurance Coverage:**

Health insurance coverage shall be provided by the Borough of Harvey Cedars to retired non-union employees until they reach the age of 65, provided that the following criteria are met:

- o The employee must have completed twenty-five (25) or more years of service credit in the state retirement system; and
- o The employee must have completed at least twenty-five (25) years of continuous service with the Borough of Harvey Cedars; and
- o The employee must have reached the age of sixty (60) at the time of retirement.

**2. Duration of Coverage:**

Eligible non-union employees shall receive health insurance coverage from the time of retirement until they reach the age of sixty-five (65), at which point coverage in retirement shall cease.

**3. Type of Coverage Provided:**

The health insurance coverage provided to eligible retired non-employees shall be the same as that which is provided to active Borough employees and subject to any changes in the Borough's health insurance plans and policies in the future.

**4. Cost of Insurance Premiums:**

The Borough of Harvey Cedars will bear the full cost of health insurance premiums for eligible retired employees, as defined in this resolution, who had at least 20 years of service in the state retirement system as of June 28, 2011. All other eligible non-union employees who did not have 20 years of service in the state retirement system as of June 28, 2011 must contribute to their Borough-provided retiree health benefits in accordance with the Tier IV grids of P.L. 2011, Ch. 78.

**5. Severability:**

If any part or provision of this resolution shall be held invalid or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other part or provision of this resolution.

**6. Effective Date:**

This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
